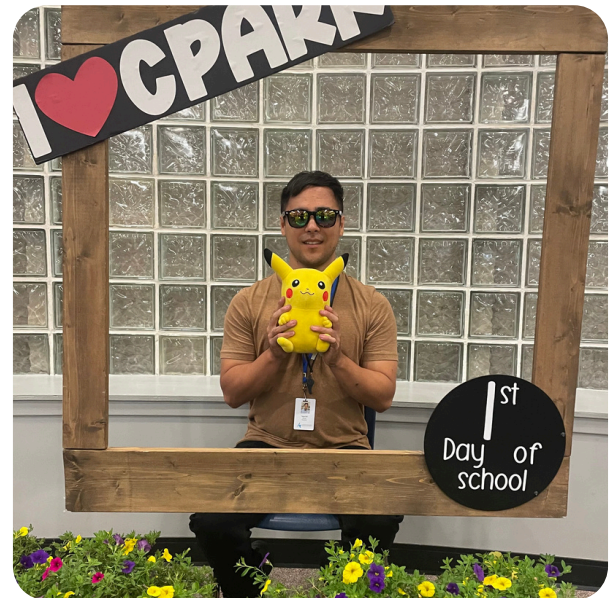
Ms. Kyle is known for her calm, kind presence and her thoughtful way of connecting with students — we're so excited to have her join our school family!
